Also, please note:

- A link to your website will be provided in your by-line or profile.
- Your content may be edited for grammar, spelling corrections or to fix links. Ms Polka Dot wants you to look your best when your contribution is published.



Polka Dot Bride will not:

- Republish content that has been published elsewhere (some exceptions can be made when content is published on your own blog). Originality is the key – this is Ms Polka Dot we're dealing with here!
- Hide your link behind a text link (i.e. "Wedding dresses" links to "www.Your Wedding Dress shop.com"). If your contribution is posted, you will get your name up in lights!
- Accept contributions that have monetizing tags or affiliate links embedded in them without Ms Polka Dot's express permission. It's just not cool.
- Publish any posts, which are considered inflammatory, racist, or negative/damaging in any way. Ms Polka Dot wants this to be a happy place for everyone who visits!
